Futures 4 Me comprises a searchable, joint database of courses and qualifications, as well as supportive information and links to other useful sources of information and advice to help young people making option choices at 14 and 16.

Although 'Futures4me' is aimed primarily at young people in years 9 and 11, to help them make the key decisions as to what to study at key stage 4 and post-16, it is hoped that learners across the age range from year 8 to 12 will find it useful.

It is important that young people are introduced to the wealth of information contained in the Prospectus in a supported environment. Following discussion with colleagues across the region, it has been suggested that learners be introduced to the system through PHSCE, or careers lessons.
