

Tried & tested e-learning training

In 2006-2007 the E-Guides training programme was piloted with work-based learning providers – this was an extremely successful partnership initiative for NIACE, ALP, and CEL, with 135 providers engaging with the programme and 222 participants trained.

This year, the E-Guides training programme has been updated in line with changing technology. The work-based learning and adult and community learning materials have been combined and revised. The programme is delivered at three face-to-face training days, and small groups of participants are able to work with colleagues from their sector, and select from a range of activities that match their work-related needs. To ensure that specific sector needs are understood and addressed, one of the two trainers at each event has direct experience of work-based learning and delivered training on the pilot programme.
